VOTING INFORMATION

QUALIFICATIONS TO VOTE

You are entitled to vote on these questions if you meet the following requirements on July 17, 2010:

- You are 18 years of age or older;
- You are a Canadian citizen;
- You have been a resident of BC for at least 6 months;
- You have been a resident of or owned property in the Northside Fire Protection Service Area for at least 30 days; and
- You are not otherwise disqualified from voting.

Registration for all voters will take place at the time of voting.

Resident Electors will be required to produce 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident Property Electors If you own property in the service area but regularly reside elsewhere, you may vote as a non-resident property elector. No corporation is entitled to vote. Sections 51, 57 and 58 of the *Local Government Act* govern the registration and voting of non-resident property electors.

Non-resident property electors will be required to produce the following documents when registering to vote:

- 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.
- Proof of entitlement to register in relation to the property (proof of title is best); and
- If more than one person owns the property, written consent from the majority of the other owners that they are entitled to vote for that property ([click here](#) for a copy of this consent form).
