## WHO MAY SIGN THE ELECTOR RESPONSE FORM

You are entitled to sign this form opposing authorizing the qathet Regional District to enter into an agreement for a period of 30 years with the Municipal Finance Authority (MFA) to borrow funds for the construction of a fire hall in Lund, BC if you are an eligible resident elector or an eligible non-resident property elector of the Northside Fire Protection Local Service Area, under Section 65 and 66 of the *Local Government Act*, as set out below.

### Eligible Electors

In order to be registered as a **resident elector**, a person must meet **all** the following requirements on the day of registration:

- is age eighteen or older;
- is a Canadian citizen;
- has been a resident of British Columbia for at least six months;
- has been a resident of the Northside Fire Protection Local Service Area for at least thirty days; and
- is not disqualified from voting by the *Local Government Act* or any other act.

In order to be registered as a **non-resident property elector**, a person must meet **all** the following requirements on the day of registration:

- is not entitled to register as a resident elector for the Northside Fire Protection Local Service Area;
- is age eighteen or older;
- is a Canadian citizen;
- has been a resident of British Columbia for at least six months;
- has been a registered owner of real property within the Northside Fire Protection Local Service Area for at least thirty days; and
- is not disqualified from voting by the *Local Government Act* or any other act.

### NOTE:

In the case of multiple owners of a parcel, only one of the owners may vote as the non-resident property elector for that parcel. That owner must fill out a non-resident property elector consent form as written permission from the other property owners. Copies of forms are available at the Regional District office or by request to Michelle Jones, Manager of Administrative Services (contact information below).

Properties owned in full or in part by corporations are not entitled to vote.

### Northside Fire Protection Local Service Area

The Northside Fire Protection Local Service Area is a portion of Electoral Area 'A'. To view a map of this area, see the Regional District website or visit the Regional District office (address below).
