# WOODSTOVE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM

- The Woodstove Replacement Program is coordinated by the **qathet Regional District (qRD)** and is open to all residents in the qathet Regional District. Woodstove Replacement Program rebates are limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- A **\$550 Rebate** is available for replacing an uncertified wood stove with an electric heat pump, an EPA-certified pellet fueled appliance, a natural gas or propane fueled appliance, or an electric fireplace insert.
- A **\$350 Rebate** is available for replacing an uncertified wood stove with an EPA-certified wood stove.

## Conditions

- Only one rebate per taxable residence per year.
- A second-hand heating appliance does not qualify as a replacement appliance.
- The value of the rebate must not exceed the value of the new heating appliance.
- Rebate tracking numbers are required and will be issued through the qathet Regional District. Please contact Let's Talk Trash at 604.485.2260 ext.308 or email: [info@letstalktrash.ca](mailto:info@letstalktrash.ca).
- Both the old woodstove and the new heating appliance must meet the rebate program requirements. For more details visit: [powellriverrd.bc.ca/woodstoveexchange](http://powellriverrd.bc.ca/woodstoveexchange)

## To Receive the Rebate:

- The old woodstove must be inspected by a Wood Energy Technical Training (WETT) certified technician to certify the age of the old woodstove.
- If you are replacing an old wood burning appliance with a new wood burning appliance, the WETT certified technician must certify that the new appliance and chimney meet current WETT and current safety certified standards.

**Note:** You are responsible for obtaining the appropriate building permit required for installation of a new wood burning appliance.

## STEP 1: Qualification

To qualify, the appliance being replaced must be:

- presently used as the primary heating source.
- manufactured prior to November 1, 1994. (A WETT certified technician such as your retailer or chimney sweep can assist you in verifying the age of your appliance).

## STEP 2: Application Process

This brochure is the application form and must be completed in full. Brochures are available at local retailers and at the qathet Regional District office.

Applicants must pre-qualify by email, phone or in person to receive a tracking number. This tracking number will be used to verify the purchase and installation of your new heating appliance, as well as verify the recycling of your old woodstove. Let's Talk Trash is happy to assist you with your rebate application.

Before installation of the new heating appliance, ensure that the old woodstove is inspected by a WETT certified technician and certified to have been manufactured before November 1, 1994.

## STEP 3: Disposal of Old Woodstove

To improve qathet Regional District air quality, to prevent old woodstoves from being reused by someone else and to ensure proper recycling, old woodstoves must be permanently disabled before being dropped off at one of the following recycling centres: Augusta Recyclers, Black Point Auto Salvage, Hi-Ball Auto Recycling or Wilde Road Sand & Gravel and signed off by an attendant or WETT certified technician.

- Doors removed and door hinges bludgeoned
- Ash and brick liner removed
- Flue collar bludgeoned

## STEP 4: Submit Application

Make sure you provide:

- A copy of purchase receipt
- A copy of WETT inspection report
- Both sides of this brochure completed
- A photo of the old wood burning appliance installed in the home.
- A photo of the new, properly installed appliance

Please ensure that this application is completed in full and that all requested supporting documents are attached. The qRD will mail you a rebate cheque within six weeks of receiving your application. The deadline for submitting your application is ten (10) weeks following the date of purchase. Applications received after ten (10) weeks will not be considered.

## STEP 5: How Did You Hear About This Rebate Program?

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
